

The Kuranda train trip



The Kuranda train line is

- more than 1 hundred years old
- heritage listed.



Heritage listed means special to our history.



The train goes all the way from **Cairns** to **Kuranda**.

Kuranda is a village in a rainforest.




The trip goes for 2 hours.



On the trip you will

- learn about local history
- see old and beautiful nature, like rainforests and waterfalls.



You can choose which **class** to book for your trip.

Class means level of service.

1 Heritage Class

Heritage Class is our traditional style service.




Some of the train carriages are more than 100 years old.

You can book Heritage Class for the 2 trains that leave from



- Cairns and go through Freshwater in the morning
- Kuranda in the afternoon.



2 Gold Class

Gold Class is our **luxury** service.

- elegant or stylish.

The seats are like lounge or sofa chairs.

You can book Gold Class for the trains that

leave from

• Cairns at 9.30 am






- Freshwater at 9.55 am
- Kuranda at 3.30 pm.

There are 3 main stations on the train line.



You can choose where to

- get on the train
- get off the train.



1 Cairns station

The trains go from Cairns to

- Freshwater station
- Kuranda station.

Cairns to Freshwater takes about 25 minutes.

Freshwater to Kuranda takes about 1 hour and 25 minutes.

There are 2 train services from Cairns every day.



The trains leave Cairns at

• 8.30 am



• 9.30 am.



2 Freshwater station

Freshwater station is where most people choose to get on.



The train goes from **Freshwater** station to **Kuranda** station.

There are 2 train services from Freshwater every day.

The trains leave Freshwater at

• 8.55 am



• 9.55 am.



The trains get to Kuranda at

- 10.25 am
- 11.25 am.


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Barron Falls



Between **Freshwater** station and **Kuranda** station there is a stop for 15 minutes at **Barron Falls**.

Barron Falls is **not** a full station.



You can get off the train to see the waterfall from the platform.





There is a big gap between the train and platform.



If you **cannot** use steps you need to stay on the train for the Barron Falls stop.

3 Kuranda station

There are 2 return trips from **Kuranda** every day.





The trains go from Kuranda back toFreshwater station

• Cairns station.



The trains leave Kuranda at

• 2 pm



• 3.30 pm.





The trains get to Freshwater at

- 3.32 pm
- 5.02 pm.





• 3.55 pm



• 5.25 pm.





If you travel with a carer

A carer can be

- a family member or friend
- a paid support worker.



A carer can travel with you for free if you have

• a disability



and

• a **Companion Card** or a similar card from another country.



When you book your trip we will ask you

- the name of the carer
- the type of card and the card number



• if you need any other help when you travel.

If you travel with a mobility device

A **mobility device** is equipment you use to move around.

For example

- a walker
- a wheelchair.



When you book you can say if you need help to move around.




For example, help to
